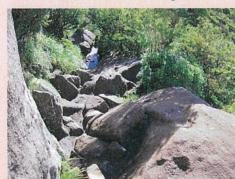
Fresh Green (May) Silver Frost (Dec. to Feb.)





The top of Mt.Kutsukake is very rocky. You can use the latter to go down the rocks and proceed to the ridge route. Be careful not to slip down. This place used to be the entrance to the sacred place when the mountain religion was flourished. At that time, peole took off their dirty shoes or slippers here and hang them on the trees. Let's try the popular trail in Kuju! One way: one and a half hours

Makinoto Pass~Mt.Ogigahana

The Kuju range is a popular destination for hikers. It has the highest mountain in the mainland Kyushu named Mt. Nakadake and other mountains higher than 1,700m. Here, we are introducing the trail starting from Makinoto Pass leading to Mt.Ogigahana. This course is easy to follow even for beginners and has a lot of spots to see.

In Kuju, the early summer (from the late May to the middle fo June) is the best season to see the blossoms of Miyamakirishima. Mt.Ogigahana, as well as Mt.Hiji and Mt.Taisen, is one of the popular spots for the blossoms. It takes more than four hours one way to hike from Chojabaru trailhead to Mt.Hiji or Mt.Taisen. To Mt.Ogigahana, however, takes only one and a half hours one way from Makinoto trailhead. If you have little confidence in your physical strength but want to see the blossoms, it is the ideal destination for you. It is breath-taking to see the mountain top covered with the pink blossoms. In autumn, you can see colorful autumn leaves there.

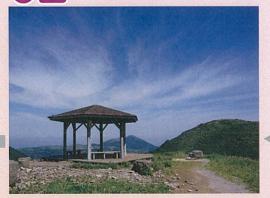
